Wheat

Qualifications: Deliver wheat into ADM's supply shed: Evansville, IN; St. Louis, MO

PRACTICE	COMPENSATION	REQUIREMENTS
Data entry in FBN Gradable	\$1.50/acre	Complete data entry by January of the following year.
No-till or strip till	\$2.00/acre	Producer choice of either no-till or strip till; both qualify and are compensated equally.
Living roots year-round	\$3.00/acre	Either double crop after wheat or follow wheat with a cover crop. Find state guidelines at efotg.sc.egov.usda.gov .
Nutrient management	\$1.50/acre	Fall within the Environmental Defense Fund N-balance safe zone. Learn more about N-balance at edf.org/ecosystems/making-invisible-loss-nitrogen-visible .
Carbon neutrality	\$15/acre (regardless of practices employed)	Data indicates a net carbon value of 0 or less.

Requirements for all:

- 1 Must not be part of any private regenerative ag program. Participation in public-funded program is accepted.
- 2 Completion of an enrollment survey/contract (5-10 min)
- 3 Completion of data collection and a closing survey (15-45 min)
