Canada's Clean Fuel Regulations (CFR)

Overview

CFR is an integral part of Canada's climate plan, aiming to reduce the carbon intensity of fuels and promote the use of cleaner technology. ADM is actively engaged in sustainability initiatives including programs incentivizing sustainable agricultural practices and the production of low-carbon intensity feedstocks. Producers who provide an attestation and meet CFR requirements are eligible to sell grain into the CFR market.

By collaborating with you, ADM aims to facilitate compliance with the CFR regulations. By sharing this data with ADM, you're not just gaining access to ADM's extensive logistic capabilities - you're positioning yourself to benefit from a truly global marketplace, potentially leading to increased opportunities.

According to the Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC), to qualify for the CFR, all feedstock must have been grown on land that is not designated as a protected area and complies with land use and biodiversity requirements.

Any producer who meets all CFR requirements and produces a crop that will be used as feedstock (such as canola, corn, wheat, and soybeans) for Canada is eligible to enroll.

Eligibility

- 1 **Wildlife Habitat** - Protection of biodiversity
- 2 **Damaging Agents** - Prevent intro/spread of invasive species
- 3 **Excluded Lands** - No net-land expansion
- 4 **Indirect Land Use Change** - No palm feedstock

Certification Requirements

- 1 Fill out the harvester declaration sheet with your ADM rep. This includes the GPS coordinates of Harvested Area.*
- 2 Sign the declaration sheet PDF and resend to ADM. Keep a copy for your records.
- 3 Direct delivery to dedicated ADM locations.**

**Only populating one set of GPS coordinates that represents your harvested area. This could be your farmyard, the location of your bins, or the entryway into a field. If farming in multiple jurisdictions (provinces/states) must provide a separate declaration for each jurisdiction that you farm in.*

***Grain delivery and attestation must comply with all requirements set forth in the CFR. There will be an annual enrollment for this policy.*
